Gala Event Beneficiary:	<p>The Harlem Junior Tennis & Education Program develops champions in tennis, education, and wellness. HJTEP continues to bring tennis to youth from high-risk, low-income inner-city neighborhoods while offering opportunities for self-development, emphasizing education and a positive code of behavior. Tennis teaches kids essential life skills, sportsmanship, self-discipline, social and emotional competence and how to lead healthier lives. HJTEP insists on academic achievement, and the average GPA of participants is 3.1. About 800 students are served annually during the school year, and 150 – 300 are served in the summer program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 95% of participants earn a high school diploma, compared to the 67% of students who graduate from high school citywide and only 25% in Central Harlem • 25% earn tennis scholarships to leading colleges • 65% receive non-athletic financial aid • 80% attend college at leading private and public institutions
